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Conditions and Declaration

- 1) Applicants must complete all sections of the application form, in particular care should be taken to enter your mobile phone number and email address clearly as these will be used to contact you should you be offered a placement.
- 2) The three pages of the completed application form should be stapled in the top left hand corner. Loose pages will not be accepted.
- 3) Students should submit one application form only for each project type.
- 4) A student will normally not be allowed to participate in more than one project during the academic year.
- 5) The question on Medical conditions cannot be left blank, if you do not suffer from any medical conditions you must state this. If you have a medical condition please give as much detail as possible. Note that details of medical conditions may be passed on to our partner college if you are offered a place at that college. Students may be required to submit Covid 19 vaccination certificates if these are required to travel, or by the host organisation/employer.
- 6) Next of Kin is the person who will be contacted in the first instance by the college in the event of an emergency while you are abroad. Normally this will be a family member.
- 7) In applying for a project you agree to make yourself familiar with the rules associated with participation on the project.
- 8) If you are offered and accept a place on a project you agree to participate fully in any preparatory activities organised by the college. This may include: Online language learning assessment and training, Cultural preparation, vocational preparation and project related educational activities.
- 9) Under no circumstances may students make direct contact with our project partners, employers or accommodation prior to travel. All contact must be made through the college Projects Coordinator.
- 10) All travel arrangements will be made by the college, students should not make their own travel arrangements unless they have been specifically instructed to do so.
- 11) All accommodation arrangements will be made by the college in consultation with our host partners, students should not make their own accommodation arrangements unless they have been specifically instructed to do so.
- 12) Students participating on projects will normally be expected to share accommodation in order to keep costs at a reasonable level.
- 13) Once you are offered and accept a place on a project you take on financial liability for costs incurred should you fail to travel or should you return early from your period abroad. These costs may include travel costs, accommodation costs and insurance.
- 14) The college code of conduct and work placement code of conduct apply while you are abroad and the college reserves the right to terminate your project at any time should you fail to comply with the provision of these codes. Should your project be terminated for this reason you will be liable for all costs incurred as a result.
